



Sway Bowmen Summer League - Rules

- The league is open to all club members and available every practice session, Weds PM and Sat AM from the official start until the Saturday one week prior to the Outdoor champs. (This year: Weds 8/5/2019 to Sat 7/9/2019). Prizes will be awarded at the Outdoor Championships.
- Your position will be determined by the grand total of your 3 highest adjusted scores and the distance bonus that has been applied to each.
- Qualifying rounds will be a single distance 3 dozen (Metric or Imperial) or a 4 dozen Warwick (i.e. 2 dozen at longer distance, 2 dozen at shorter distance).
- **A Metric 3 Dozen** shot on a 122cm face can be shot over 20 30 40 50 60 or 70m and use 10 zone metric scoring.
- **An Imperial 3 Dozen** shot on a 122cm face can be shot over 20 30 40 50 60 or 80yds and use 5 zone imperial scoring. NB. Scoresheets for the 252-badge scheme can also be submitted to this league allowing archers to earn their badges and climb the league at the same time.
- **Warwick rounds** shot on a 122cm face can be from a Short Junior Warwick (30yds/20yds) up to and including a Long Warwick (80yds/60yds).
- You can submit as many rounds of each type as you like, but you will not appear in the league list until your first 3 scores have been submitted. **At least 3 Warwick rounds must be shot during the course of the league for final qualification.**
- Only 1 score can be submitted per session and scoresheets must be verified by another archer, coach or field captain.
- 1 end of 6 sighters is allowed, they must be immediately followed by the round and be your first end of shooting i.e. no other practice before the session or during the round.
- Scores are 'league rating' adjusted. Your league rating will progress as you improve your scores over the season in the same way as a handicap. Like your handicap your league rating cannot get worse (higher) during the season only better (lower).
- 3 Dozen scores can improve your league rating, but they will not affect your official club handicap. However, 'Warwick Rounds' are officially recognised by Archery GB and will therefore be passed to the records officer for determination of your outdoor club handicap.
- Archers will be placed in a division dependent upon their initial league rating, grouping archers of similar ability together. 3 divisions for Recurve/Compound, 1 Division for Longbow/Barebow.
- For current archers your league rating at the start of the league will equal your starting outdoor handicap for the year according to the SB Records Officer. New shooter's league rating will be determined once 3 scored rounds have been submitted to the league.
- Positions will be updated and published at least once a week. At the end of the league honours will go to the first 3 positions in each division with a prize or trophy for 1st position.
- Distance bonuses are as follows:

Long Warwick (80yd/60yd)	80yd/70m	10
